

Project Synopsis

Forming part of Fife Council's Building Fife's Future Programme, Auchmuty High School is the second High School in the programme to be successfully completed, helping to enhance important educational assets for the local community.

Building on the knowledge gained through the development and construction of its award winning sister school, Dunfermline High School, Auchmuty High School has been developed with this learning at its heart. Focused on the needs of its pupils, the environment and the wider local community, the school offers market leading facilities, including 3G pitches, sports facilities, arts and drama spaces and advanced teaching spaces, providing state of the art facilities for learning and development. The school is further supported by an array of sustainable technologies, including bio-mass boiler facilities, a wind turbine, solar panels and rainwater harvesting.

Completing during the summer of 2013, the High School successfully welcomed its first intake of pupils at the beginning of the 2013/2014 academic year.
